Winter is drawing in as Kasi 2 Kasi we took it upon ourselves to donate 144 school shoes to all the learners who attended the Kasi 2 Kasi Schools Programme Operation Fundisa Class 2023. During the period we stayed with these learners we noticed that a number of them had some challenges with their school shoes, hence we took the initiative of donating shoes to them as well as backpacks.



This was not just a handing over of shoes only the whole day was in cooperated with two very crucial sessions. The first session was about leadership and character, second session was Bullying.

The gates were open at 6am where K2K team started preparations for the event. Learners started arriving from 7:30am and registration was underway.

From 8:30am we began the programme with praise and worship then Pastor Duma opened with a prayer. Dr Lwazi Nqetho gave a powerful welcome address elaborating about the purpose of the day.



From 9am till 10 am the first session of leadership and character commenced facilitated by Mam Mabongi Magwaza, K2K Arts Skills Development Programme Director. She taught them about Leadership Skills and traits then Questions and answers.

From 10am till 12midday the second session started Mr Gah Ndlela, Gospel singer and police officer, came up and introduced the topic, gender based violence under bullying, after a brief introduction he then introduced Ms Zama Sikhakhane a social worker from Wentworth Victim Friendly Center who elaborated more on the topic.





After these two sessions various guests gave messages of supports.
